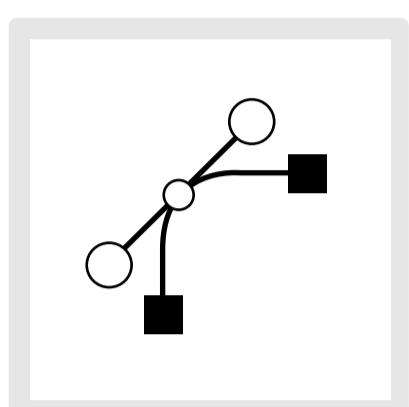

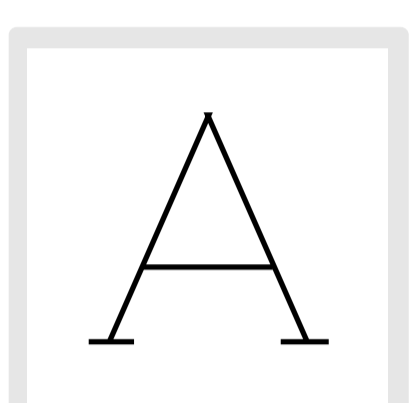
FILE FORMAT

Please submit your files in **JPG**, **PNG** or **PSD** format.



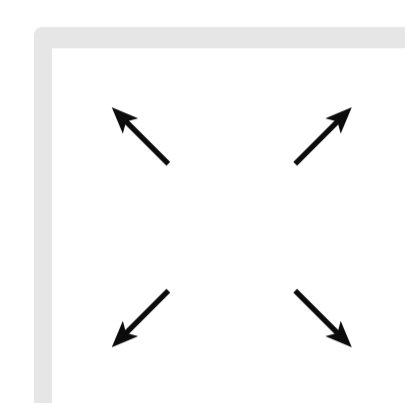
COLOR

All colors should be in **RGB**.



FONTS

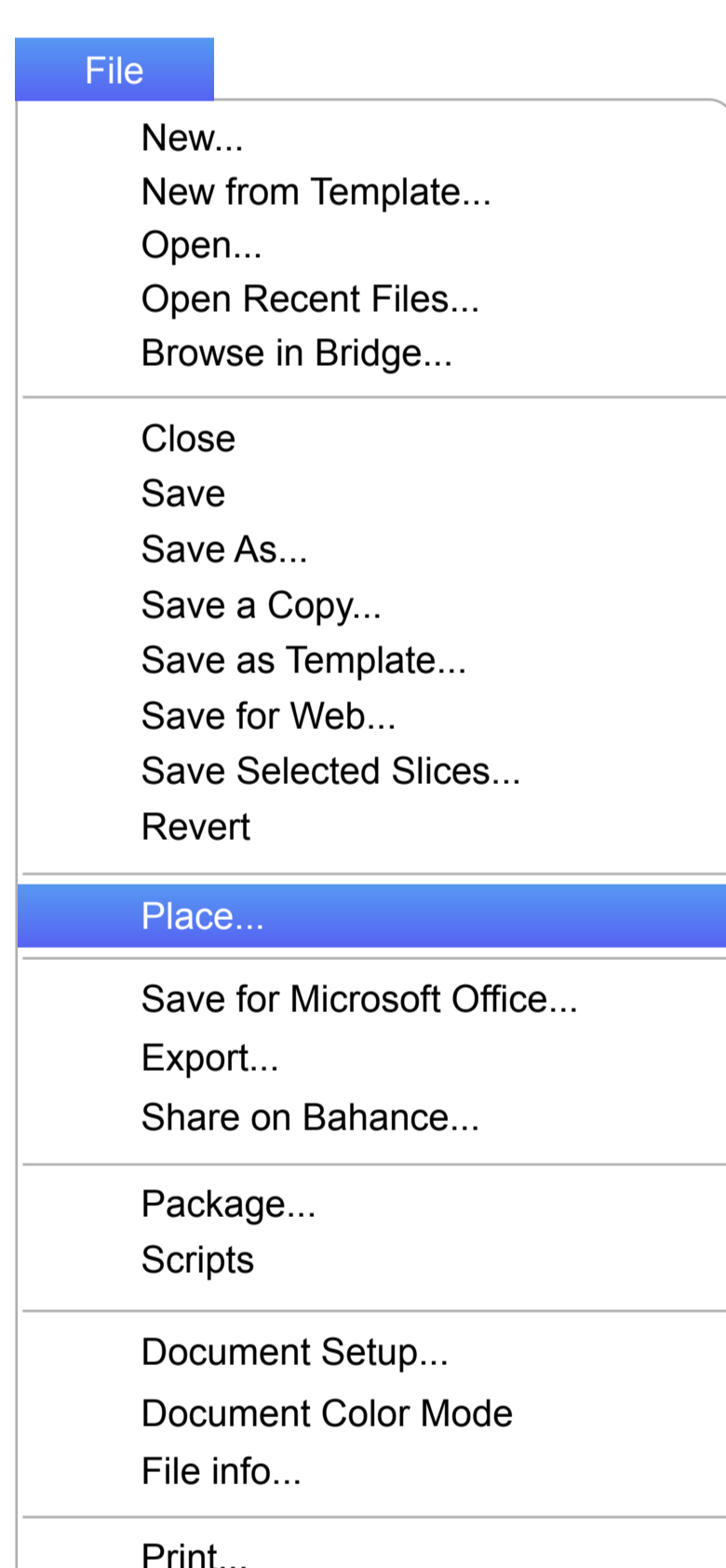
Instructions on how to prepare a printfile

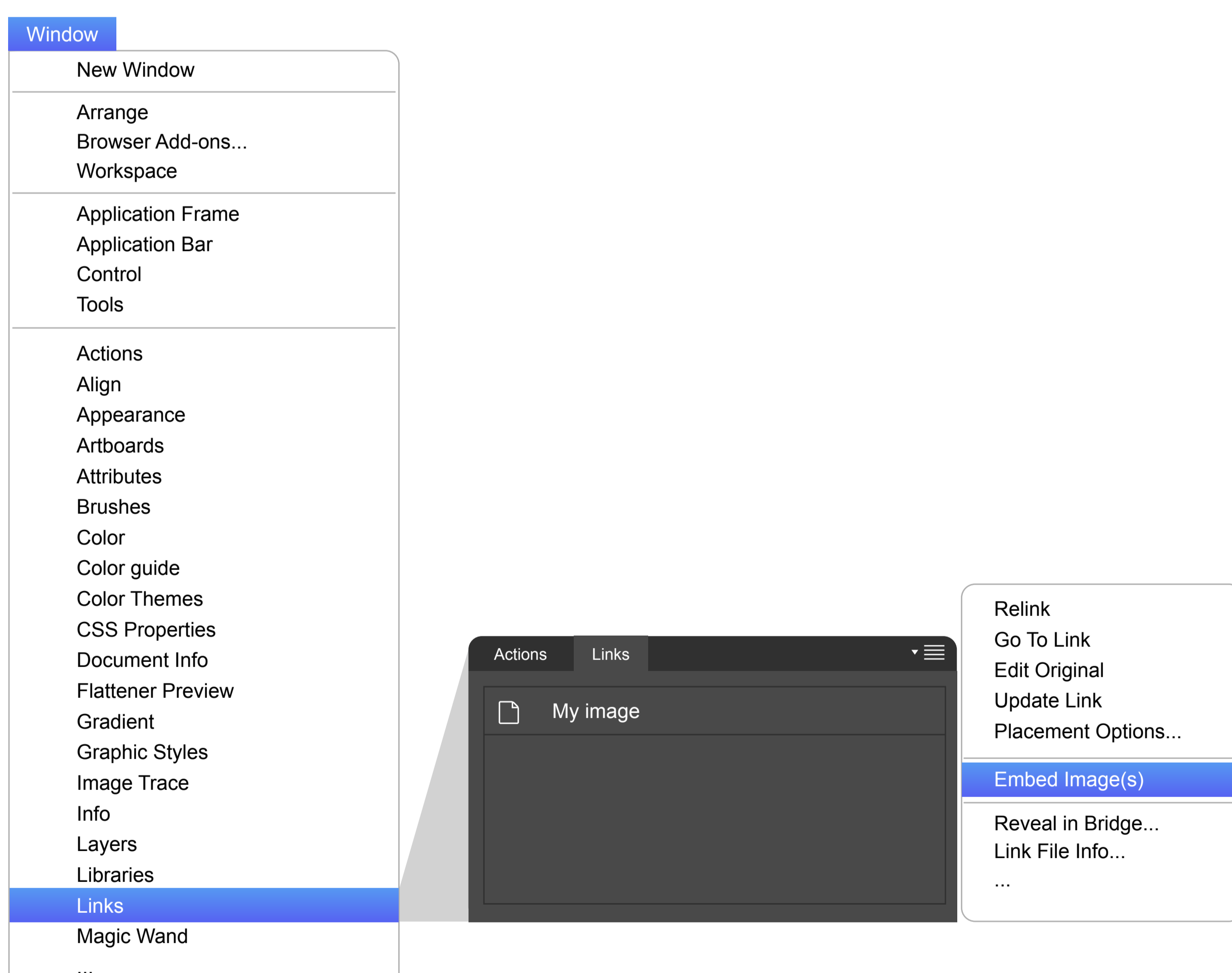
- 1 CREATE** new document sized to Width: 36" x Height: 32"
 - Make sure your **resolution is 150dpi** or higher
 - Make sure the color space is set to **RGB**

- 2 PLACE** raster graphics or create / copy & paste vector graphics within maximum graphic size area.

Pay attention to graphics resolution (see requirements above).

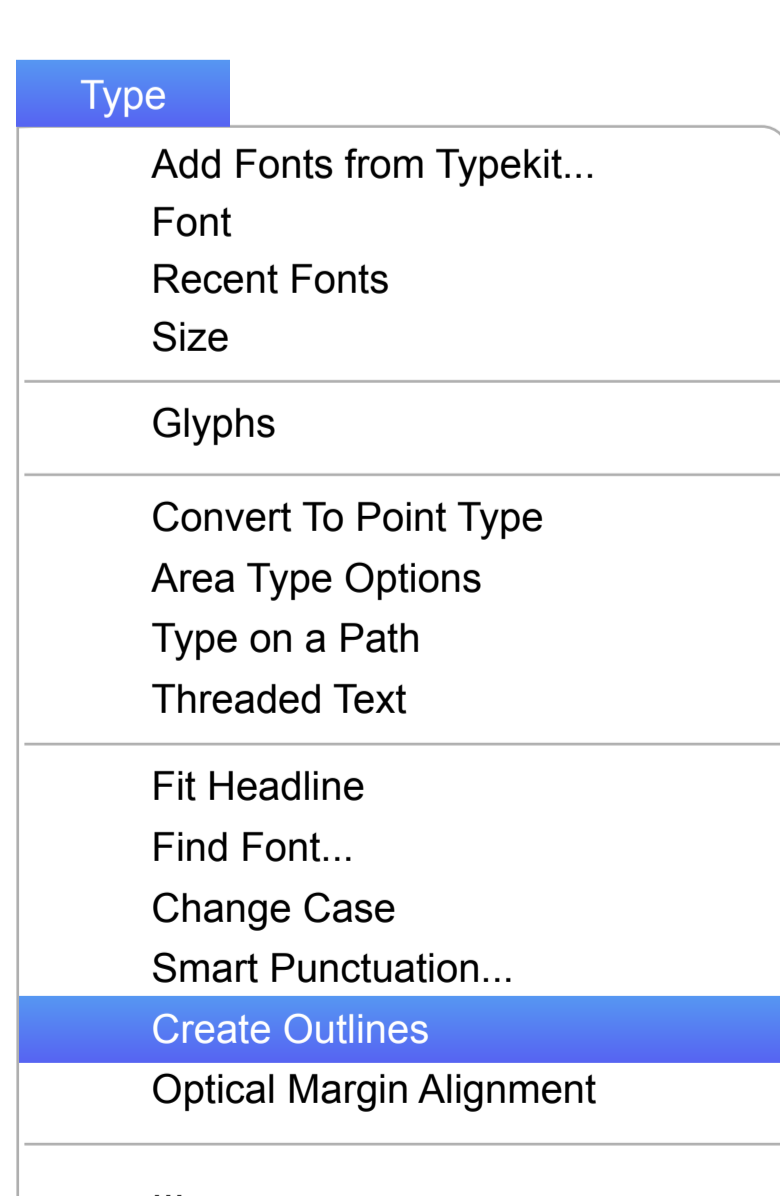


- 3 EMBED** raster graphics



- 4 CREATE OUTLINES** of all vector fonts

Select text first



- 5 EXPORT**

1. Choose "File" - "Export"
2. Rename your file
3. Choose either **.jpg** or **.png** as the file format
4. Click the **"Use Artboards"** checkbox
5. Click "Export"
6. Make sure your **resolution is 150dpi** or higher
7. Make sure the color space is set to **RGB**
8. Click **"OK"** to save file

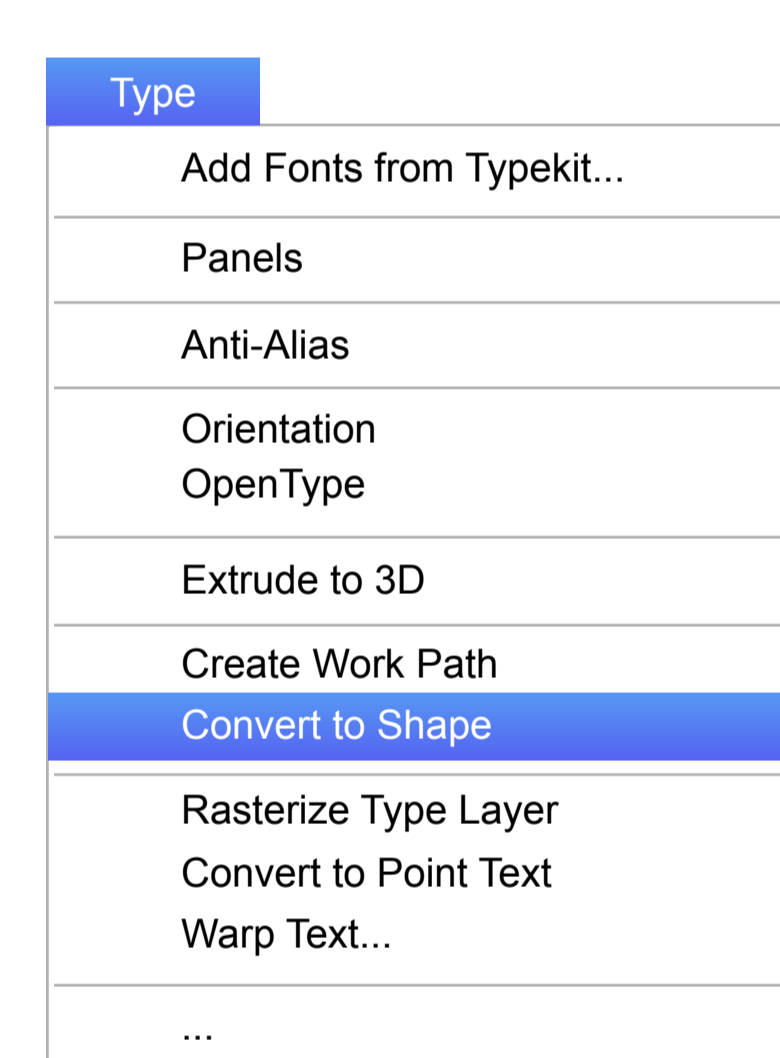
- 1 OPEN** The Printful template or **CREATE** new document

- 2** Create or copy / paste graphics within maximum graphic size area.

Pay attention to graphics resolution (see requirements above).

- 3 CONVERT TO SHAPE** all vector fonts

Select text layer first



- 4 SAVE**
 1. Turn off the guides by using the eye icon tool
 2. Choose File - Save As and Rename your file
 3. Save as .jpg
